Entry Restrictions

Please note that entry restrictions may be subject to change on short notice.

You are responsible for ensuring that you are allowed entry into the country you are travelling to or are in transit through.

Passengers arriving from within the European Area are allowed to enter France if compiling with the travel requirements below. Passengers from outside the European Area are only allowed to enter France under specific circumstances.

COVID-19 Test Requirements

All passengers from the age of 11 years must present proof of a ONE of the following:

1. Medical Certificate with proof of a negative COVID-19 test (Antigen,PCR)

The test must be performed no earlier than 72 hours before departure.

2. COVID-19 Vaccination Certificate

The Certificate will be recognized for passengers and their accompanying children under 18 years old:

-2 weeks after the second dose of Pfizer, Moderna, Oxford/AstraZeneca

-4 weeks after the single and only dose Janssen (Johnson & Johnson)

-2 weeks after the first dose of any of Pfizer, Moderna, Oxford/AstraZeneca if you have previously tested positive for COVID-19

The certificates must be in English or French.

All passengers from the age of 11 years old may be subject to COVID-19 testing upon arrival in France.

Document Requirements
